# Rapid Re-Housing (RRH) Programs

### **Program Purpose:**

Assist individuals and families experiencing *homelessness* to secure and retain permanent, affordable rental housing in the community and to achieve greater levels of self-sufficiency, independence, recovery and overall improved quality of life.

### **Target Population:**

Households with moderate needs that require *short to medium-term rental assistance and time-limited supports* in order to secure and maintain permanent housing stability in the community.

## **Key Components:**

- Short to medium-term rental assistance with time-limited supportive services
  - HAWC Community Partners administer the ongoing, monthly rental assistance
  - o Various non-profit organizations provide supportive services
- Participants apply for tenancy with private landlords
  - o Landlords use their normal tenant selection criteria
- Gross Rents (monthly rent plus a HOM-calculated utility allowance) must be at or below HUDpublished Fair Market Rents
- Gross Rents must be considered reasonable in comparison to similar unassisted units
- Units must meet HUD's Housing Quality Standards (HQS)
- Units must be free from Lead Based Paint
- HAWC Community Partners assist participant with turning on any required utilities
- Tenant and landlord execute landlord's standard lease
- HAWC Community Partners and landlords execute rental assistance agreement
- HAWC Community Partners calculate Tenant Rent and Housing Assistance Payment (HAP)
  - Tenant pays Tenant Rent directly to landlord
  - o HAWC Community Partners pay HAP to landlord
- Service providers provide *client-centered*, wrap –around supportive services to tenants in their homes and in the community
- HAWC Community Partners acts as liaison between landlord, tenant and supportive services provider for tenancy-related issues

## **Program Scope:**

- HAWC Community Partner programs assisted 14 individuals in 2014.
- HAWC Community Partner programs assisted **44 families** in 2014.
- Supportive Services for Veterans and Families RRH Community Partner programs assisted **30 individuals** 2014.
